

Scholarship Application Instructions

Greetings! Attached you will find a Scholarship Application from the I Love My Artist Foundation Scholarship. It is extremely important that you follow the instructions listed below in order to be considered eligible for a scholarship award. **This award is only open to U.S. residents attending U.S. institutions.**

1. You must be currently enrolled in an institution of higher learning (e.g. College or Conservatory) in order to be eligible for a scholarship award. If you are still in high school, you are not eligible for this scholarship program. Please contact the Scholarship Committee for alternate scholarship information.
2. The application must be completed in its entirety with all of the necessary signatures.
